



Course Alterations

Hole 10

The ditch is now designated as a Red Penalty Area in accordance with the 2019 Rules of Golf. In the event, the player has the following relief options each under a penalty of one stroke.

1. Stroke and Distance Relief

The player may play the next stroke from where the previous stroke was made.

2. Back On the Line Relief

The player may go back, keeping the point where the ball entered the Penalty Area, in a line with the hole.

3. Lateral Relief

The player may drop the ball in a relief area measuring two club lengths from the reference point, which is the estimated point where the ball entered the Penalty Area.

Hole 11

The copse of trees on the left of the fairway is designated as a Red Penalty Area and provides the same relief options as in Hole 10. In this case however, the player may elect to play from the Penalty Area (with no penalty) and may now ground the club in making such a stroke.

Hole 14

The ditch following the line of the River Cart remains the Out of Bounds boundary of the Course. In the event, the player must take Stroke and Distance Relief.

The ditch and environs behind the 14th Green are designated a Red Penalty Area and provide the same relief options as Hole 11. The red stakes have been brought forward from the ditch to enable the player to have the option of Lateral Relief. As with Hole 11, if appropriate, the player may ground the club if playing from inside the Penalty Area.

Hole 15

The white stakes from the 15th tee following the bushes line to the " Broccoli " tree now denote the Out of Bounds boundary. The white line which is present should be ignored and the assessment of whether or not a ball is Out of Bounds will be by a notional line between each pair of stakes. Players should bear in mind that the boundary edge is defined by the line between the course-side points of the stakes and the stakes are out of bounds.
